Mr. Victor Moraru holds the position of Member of the Directorate of National Power Transmission Company Transelectrica since October 3, 2024, with a four - year mandate.

With a large experience in management, Mr. Victor Moraru has over 30 years of activity in leading positions both in local and central administration as well as in private environment. During his career he has coordinated complex strategic projects with a significant impact, proving strong managerial competences and an efficient vision on organizational development processes.

For 16 years during 2000-2016 Mr. Victor Moraru has held the position of mayor of Amara town, Ialomita county, where he has coordinated important projects for the local development, social and community politics on the administration level, both with own financing as well as with European financing. Later, during 2016 – 2020, Mr. Victor Moraru managed the Ialomita county administration at the highest level from the position of President of County Council Ialomita. Holding this leading position Mr. Victor Moraru has coordinated and achieved major development projects in fields like road infrastructure, health, education, culture, environment, administrative competence, accessing both European financing mechanisms as well as financing available through national programs of local development.

With his large experience within the public administration, Mr. Victor Moraru brought contribution to the elaboration and implementation of some efficient politics and European financing projects, proving through his accomplishments an efficient management of the resources involved in reaching institutional objectives. Mr. Victor Moraru has also consolidated his experience in strategy and leadership by holding relevant positions as member in European Committee of the Regions, 2015-2025, Vice-president of the Association of Cities in Romania 2012 – 2016, President of the National Association of Spa and Balneoclimateric Resorts in Romania, 2009-2017, as well as by getting involved in the supervision of some representative institutions at local and central level.

Through the positions held within the General Secretariat of the Government, Mr. Victor Moraru managed the National Recovery and Resilience Plan related to General Secretariat of the Government, administrating 22 stakes from National Recovery and Resilience Plan. Thus the experience gained gives Mr. Victor Moraru a large knowledge of the processes and mechanisms particular to National Recovery and Resilience Plan.

Moreover, Mr. Victor Moraru joined the management of the National Power Transmission Company Transelectrica having the deep understanding of the administrative and corporative mechanisms particular to companies with capital held by the Romanian State, gained through the activity carried on while being the vice-president of the Agency for Monitoring and Evaluating the Performances of Public Enterprises.
