









Core network operations













Transmission

- Maintenance, operation and upgrade of the national high-voltage electric backbone
- Operation of cross-border interconnection lines
- High availability (low outage) rates
- Unrestricted grid access for all users



System operation

Real time monitoring and control of the whole electricity system in Romania

- Grid balance planning and real-time i.e. close match between generation and consumption
- Calculation of back-up stand-by capacity reserves



Market balancing

Imbalance settlement process: measurement and financial settlement of grid imbalances caused by temporary generationconsumption mismatches (TSO acts as a clearing agent for the entire market)



























Roles played in the market

Market Role Market facilitator: operates Romania's main electricity **Electricity** grid Trading (own position): volumes purchased to offset transmission grid losses Single buyer Balancing capacity services Frequency regulation reserves (FCR, aFRR, mFRR, RR) purchased mainly through market-based transactions Central counterparty clearing: financial settlement of imbalances (BRPs) vs. balancing services (BSPs) Balancing energy services Own BRPs: unintended cross-border flows, shipper within CEE regional price-coupled DAM (4MMC: CZ+SK+HU+RO) Calculation and allocation/sale of available capacity Cross-border capacity to the market (market-based transactions)

















TSO independence certification

Transelectrica's independence from the market side of the power sector (generation, sale/supply), given its position as transmission and system operator (TSO) of the Romanian power grid, was certified by the Romanian Energy Regulator according to the "Ownership **Regulated segments** Unbundling" model (EC endorsement on (networks - natural monopolies) 12.10.2015) on 08.12.2015 (ANRE Order 164 -OJ 908). Certification was published in EU's Official Journal on 08.01.2016 **Transmission Distribution** Generation Sale/Supply (TSO) Certified (EC) **Ownership Unbundling** Segments where competition was introduced











Transmission fee collection




















Sector overview | Generation fleet



The chart above shows a selection of the Romania-based electricity generation fleet



















Generation mix | capacity vs. output


















10-year grid development plan






















RELATIONSHIP WITH SHAREHOLDERS AND INVESTORS


